- ✓ Respect other people.

- ✓ Behave responsibly at all times.
- ✓ Listen carefully to instructions from staff.
- ✓ Abide by the mobile phones and digital devices policy.

Expectations

Behaviour involving violence, threats, bullying, racism, theft, swearing, vaping, smoking, drinking alcohol is unacceptable and will be dealt with immediately by Summer Camp staff and the School Director. Parents will be informed if their child’s behaviour compromises the wellbeing of other pupils. Sanctions include:

- ⊖ Exclusion from class
- ⊖ Exclusion from activities
- ⊖ Removal of mobile phone and digital devices privileges
- ⊖ Expulsion from camp

- ✓ Sundays: 5, 12, 19, 26 July and 2 August from 10:00 to 11:00 CEST Swiss time.

Mobile Phones / Digital Devices Access for Ages 10-12

- ✓ After the first Wednesday, several times a week for 10-15 minutes

Mobile Phones / Digital Devices Access for Ages 13-16

- ✓ Mobile phones are allowed from lunchtime to 21:00, except during:
 - ⊖ classes
 - ⊖ meals
 - ⊖ activities
