### WINTER CAMP JANUARY - MARCH 2026

Unforgettable winter sports and language programmes for students aged from 5 to 14.



**DATES:** Sunday 11 January 2026 - Friday 20 March 2026

**ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES:** Arrive Sunday, depart Saturday

#### AGES 5-7

- **Integration Programme** within the existing school timetable, with two sessions of skiing per week. Minimum stay two weeks.

#### AGES 8-14

- **Integration Programme** within the existing school timetable, with two sessions of skiing per week. Minimum stay two weeks.
- **French or English Immersion:** 4 half days of language classes; 4 half days + one full day of skiing per week; weekend activities and/or skiing. Minimum stay two weeks.
- **Super Ski** - ski all day 5 days a week. Minimum stay one week.



## Programmes for 5 to 7 year olds

- Sunday 11 January 2026 - Friday 20 March 2026
- Integration Programme: minimum 2 weeks; CHF 7'100 day, CHF 7'500 boarding

**Fees:** Fees for longer durations are available on request.

**Extras:** See Table on page 4. Students who have no skiing ability - complete beginners - will need a private instructor for an additional fee to enable them to catch up with their classmates quickly.

- **Super Ski (SS):** no academic lessons, ski all day Monday to Friday, minimum one week
- **Integration Programme (IP):** minimum 2 weeks
- **French or English + Ski (FES):** minimum 2 weeks

## Technical Requirements

- Super Ski ski level: Only Intermediate and above. Ski only (no snowboard). Additional instructor fees for beginners.

Winter Camp fees include accommodation and full board for boarders, lunch and snacks for day students, ski equipment, ski pass, activities, excursions, uniforms, books and school materials, personal laundry for boarders, internet access and taxes. Students with no skiing ability (complete beginners) will require a private instructor for an additional fee. Note: Day Students attend from Monday to Friday 08:00 - 16:00; boarders stay on site 24/7.

## Application Process

4. If a child is travelling alone by air, please complete an **UM (Unaccompanied Minor)** form for their return journey. The form should include all the details of the person collecting your child at the destination airport.  
**A valid passport, not an ID card, is obligatory for air travel.**

## FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

A Winter Camp reservation will only be confirmed once full payment has been received. If the reservation is cancelled 65 days or fewer before the start of the course, the School reserves the right to retain any amount already paid. This clause also applies to failure to obtain a visa, out of date travel documents or being refused entry to Switzerland, early or voluntary departure from the camp, late arrival, dismissal or prolonged absence. Once the course has begun, the school retains full payment.

Requests for changes to invoices must be submitted in writing. The first change is free of charge; second and subsequent change requests are charged at CHF 25 per invoice.
