6 - 12 year olds - Dates and Fees

WHAT IS INCLUDED IN SUMMER CAMP FEES?

Full board and lodging for boarding students, lunch and a snack for day students, French or English lessons, activities, expeditions, transport for off-campus activities, Summer Camp uniform for ages 6-12, books and school materials, personal laundry for boarding students, wifi, transfers from and to Geneva Airport on official dates and schedules for boarding students, taxes and VAT.

WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED IN SUMMER CAMP FEES?

Optional extras, Swiss health and medical insurance (added to the invoice), pocket money (added to the invoice), flights to and from Switzerland, any adjudged recompense for damage caused to school property, any miscellaneous additional expenses incurred by campers e.g. online wellbeing courses.

Terms and Conditions and School Rules

- The reservation will only be effective once full payment has been received.
- The fees include a non-refundable deposit of CHF 500 (see Cancellation Policy below).
- Discounts: If siblings from the same family are enrolled at Summer Camp for the same session, a discount of 10% is applied for the second child, 15% for the third child and 20% for the fourth and subsequent children.
- If several siblings attend Summer Camp for the same session, they must be either all boarding students or all day students. It is not possible to mix the statuses.
- No refund will be given for a change of status from a boarding to day student during the course of the summer camp. Changing from day student to boarding student during a session will incur additional fees levied at the complete session boarding rate and is subject to availability.
- The School does not organise accommodation or transportation for parents, chaperones, agents or other family members.
- Parents of day students must make their own arrangements for bringing their child to and from school.
- Day students attend from 08:50 to 18:00 Monday to Saturday in the first week, and 08:50 to 18:00 Monday to Friday in the second week.
- Day students cannot be accommodated before the drop off time in the morning or after the drop off time in the evening, unless an early or late activity has been planned and parents have been informed.
- For child safeguarding reasons, parents, chaperones, guardians and other family members may not enter any part of the school campus, including access roads, car parks, school buildings and play areas, except at official arrival and departure times or by appointment. All visitors must sign in at Reception and they will be accompanied by a member of La Garenne staff at all times.
- Students may not have GPS locators or connected devices on their person e.g. AirTag, Apple Watch. If found, these will be confiscated and returned at the end of the camp. Only mobile phones or tablets may be used for Family Time sessions, not smart watches (e.g. Huawei). Day students may not bring mobile phones or other devices to school.
- If students wear jewellery, or have any valuable or dangerous item (e.g. wristwatch, Swiss Army knife) on their person, please note that we may require that these be removed by staff for health and safety reasons. La Garenne Services SA does not accept any responsibility for any loss of, or damage to jewellery, clothing, money, credit and debit cards or any other item brought to the Camp by a student. Parents are reminded that they should have insurance to cover their children's personal effects.
- We reserve the right to modify the programme and fees in response to changes in weather conditions or any other reason necessary for the smooth operation of the camp. We do not issue detailed schedules in advance to parents, students or agents.
- Photos of students may be published on our social networks and website. Parents should complete this form <https://www.la-garenne.ch/photo-and-video-consent/> If you do not wish your child's image to be shown, please inform us in writing. However, we cannot guarantee that a student will not be shown in a group photo. We also cannot guarantee that all students will be featured.
- Occasionally it may be necessary to charge additional fees during the course of the Summer Camp, for example for damage to school property, for online health and safety courses (vaping, alcohol) and so on. Payment is obligatory.
- Students departing later than our advertised departure times on the final day may be subject to concierge fees of CHF 130 per hour.
- Requests for supporting Visa Application letters are treated on an individual basis and depend on assurances of the integrity of the request.
- Requests for changes to extra options, sessions, boarding or day status must be submitted in writing. Change requests are charged at CHF 25 per updated invoice. Payment reminders are charged at CHF 25.
- In the event of litigation between the school and the parents, Swiss Legislation is the only law applicable in all matters.



Cancellation Policy

- If a Summer Camp place is cancelled 65 days or more before the start of the session, the school refunds the amount paid minus CHF 500.
- If a place is cancelled fewer than 65 days before the start of the session, or after the session has started, the school retains full payment.
- Full payment is also retained in the event of a student's early or voluntary departure, late arrival, dismissal or absence due to illness, family emergency etc.
- It is not possible to change a Summer Camp session within 65 days of the start of the booked session. In this instance, it counts as a cancellation and no refund can be given.
- If a student or parents cancel an optional extra within 28 days of the start of the camp or after the session has begun, no refund will be given.
- We do not issue refunds for students who cannot travel because their travel documents are out of date, or if they are denied boarding for any reason. It is the parents' responsibility to ensure that all documentation is valid for travel. Passports are required for air travel.
- If a global pandemic is declared by official agencies such as the World Health Organisation, and students cannot travel due to resulting worldwide restrictions, we either refund camp fees in full in Swiss francs, or offer a credit note which can be put towards a future stay (academic, summer, winter, or integration), valid for two years.
- In the absence of a formal declaration of a global pandemic, students who choose not to travel will not be refunded within 65 days of the start of their planned Summer Camp session.

We strongly recommend parents take out insurance to cover all eventualities.
